Scope of Work: Olive Tree Replacement

Greetings,

An Olive tree replacement was scheduled at the Staley Avenue site for Wednesday, October 11, 2017. I was at the site to observe BrightView Tree Company remove and replace a mature Olive tree.

The Olive tree that was slated for removal was in serious decline with one major limb completely dead and dried out. As the tree was being removed I noticed that dead stem portion had no viable living roots attached to it.

I had previously inspected this tree which was tagged with a #706 ID number. In 2008 the tree was rated in poor condition and had further declined since then.

The replacement tree was delivered by BrightView and well protected for the transport from the nursery. The foliage was well protected and no damage resulted from the transport. A tractor was used to maneuver the tree up the slope to the planting location. The landscape team was able to move the tree into the planting location without any damage to the tree. The tree was planted correctly and placed at the right planting height. A retaining

berm was made and the trees root ball was properly irrigated. I felt that the planting of the tree was successful.

The replacement tree should be able to flourish and grow. I think that the replacement tree is definite improvement from the removed tree.

Trees are living organisms and their life span cannot be predicted.
